Grand Marshal
John M. Mavroudis



John Mavroudis spent his adult life in Alpine with his wife Anne and their two children, Michael and Lauren, who attended the Alpine School. John was commissioned as an infantry lieutenant in 1969, then attended the officer's school in Ft. Benning, Georgia after graduating law school in 1972. John continued to serve in the Army Infantry Reserve until 1977 when he was honorably discharged as a Captain. John was preceded in military service by his two brothers, Infantry Major Antonio who was awarded numerous medals for gallantry in combat in Vietnam including the silver star and bronze medals, and Infantry Captain Steve who served in Korea and Vietnam. Their father, Michael, served in the Navy in the Pacific during WW II. Antonio died in combat action on his third tour in Vietnam in 1967.

John had a successful real estate career as one of the founding partners of the Rio Vista Group, which in the 70s and 80s developed many homes respectful of Alpine's single-family residential-only zoning. He was a recipient of the 1999 Ellis Island Medal of Honor. John was active in the Tenaflly Cathedral and National Greek Orthodox Church, where he served as the General Counsel under His Eminence Archbishop Spyridon of America. John was appointed an Archon of the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople, the highest lay award in Eastern Orthodoxy. John served as a member of the Board of Trustees of Syracuse College of Law and on numerous national institutions and organizations of the Greek Orthodox Church of America.

We are honored to have Mr. Mavroudis as our Grand Marshal and are immeasurably grateful to him and his family for their service and sacrifice to our country.
