#### Discussion of the Proposed Budget

Mr. Bliss from the firm of Lerch, Vinci & Higgins, LLP was present and reviewed the distributed copies of his 2022 Budget Overview. Mr. Bliss reviewed all revenues and appropriations and presented to the Mayor and Council with a clear understanding of the budget scheduled for introduction at the regular meeting to follow.

The municipal rate will go from 17.7cents per \$100 of assessed value to 18.2 cents, a \$138 per year increase for a property assessed at \$2,763,000.

The tax collection rate for 2021 was 98.43%

The Mayor thanked Mr. Bliss and Ms. Hayward for their work on the budget process.
