REPORT OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT: for the reporting period 9/1/2019-11/30/2019. A copy is on file. Highlights as follows:

Authorized Agent (Engineer): 1 test holes inspection, 5 septic plan reviews, 5 septic system permits in progress with 1 new this reporting period; 4 septic repair permits complete and 1 pending, 24 septic systems substantially complete pending final inspections (not including 3 finally inspected since the last report);

3 AWPTD licenses actively monitored; 18 other reviews include 3 zoning board reviews, 8 realty transfer septic inspection reports (RTSIRs), 3 Requests CCO (continuing certificate of occupancy), 1 CNC (Certificate of Noncompliance), 1 tenant complaint – septic backup - resolved, 1 DEP permit review

REHS: 1 Ch. 24 restaurant inspection, 1 potable water samplings, 4 animal bite investigations, 1 child lead investigation, 3 special event inspections.

BCDHS Nursing: Alpine School Immunization Audit Report submitted to State.

BC Animal Control 9 patrols, 2 fox, 1 cat impounded, 1 deer, 1 unknown.

Public education continued displays VAPING, ovarian, prostate, lung cancer, diabetes awareness, HPV vaccination, free fitness classes, NJ Walk for Wellness in the Park for addition, Lung Cancer Awareness, Strengthening Families workshop.

BUSINESS – Board asked for update on Alpine Three application. Their application for seven units with a mile long forced main sewer line to Cresskill is currently before the Planning Board. They were heard in October and November and will be heard again next Tuesday where continued testimony and public questions are expected.
