

***If you have a cat or dog, it MUST be licensed.***

**Borough Ordinances and State Law require each dog or cat to be licensed each year by January 31<sup>st</sup> and regulate the deadlines for late fees and fines. Our office DOES NOT have leeway to waive the requirements.**

The Borough send reminder letters, phone call reminders, and late notices as a courtesy (not required) via town-wide mailings.

**Pet Licenses renewed (received or postmarked) after January 31<sup>st</sup> will be assessed late fees.**

**By State Law, your pet's rabies vaccination must be valid through November 1**

**If there is a medical reason for not updating their vaccine, a VPH-28 form (available from our office) must be completed by owner & vet.**

**Please note the Alpine Board of Health also requires licenses to keep poultry (such as chickens) and hooved animals (such as horses).  
Check before you acquire.**

***You must provide the form (available on our website) with fee and rabies vaccination certificate valid through November 1.***

***Vets are open for rabies vaccinations by appointment so please plan accordingly.***
